



Paul VI High School Application Materials Checklist 2019-2020

Eighth grade students applying to the class of 2024 must submit the following:

- Application Form** – Students wishing to apply to the class of 2024 must use our online application, available on our website, www.pvihs.org
 - *Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.*
 - Students who submit applications by January 24, 2020 will be eligible to register at Paul VI on the official registration day, February 22, 2020.

- Personal Essay** – Students are requested to submit a 250-word essay.
 - The essay should be uploaded as part of the online application.
 - Instructions for the essay are provided in the application form.

- HSPT Test Scores** – All students wishing to enter the Paul VI Class of 2024 must take the High School Placement Test (HSPT).
 - **The HSPT for the Paul VI Scholarships is offered on Saturday, October 26;** scores from other locations or dates or dates will not be accepted for scholarship purposes.
 - Students who choose to test at a location other than Paul VI must arrange for scores to be sent to the Paul VI Registrar by January 24, 2020.
 - To register for the HSPT, please visit our website, www.pvihs.org.

- Official Transcripts** – Applicants must arrange for the academic records to be sent to Paul VI High School. Records must include:
 - Report card grades from grades 6, 7, and the first marking period of grade 8.
 - Standardized test scores from grades 6 and 7.
 - Please note: The Camden Diocese provides an Information Sheet to Catholic school students; students may choose to use that information sheet to have their transcripts sent to Paul VI. **Students must also fill out the Paul VI application to be considered for admission to Paul VI High School.**

Upon receipt of the application, Paul VI High School will send an admission decision to the student.
