4x 100m- Senior girls came in 3rd place Running were Amelia, Mary, Julie, & Ellie .

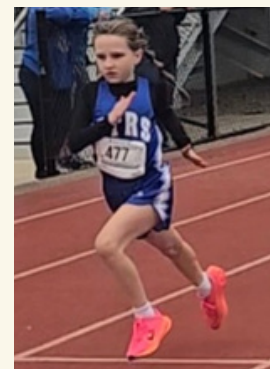
4x200m- Cadet girls came in 2nd place Isabella., Rhae., Aria, Jacqueline

A GREAT WAY TO END THE SEASON!

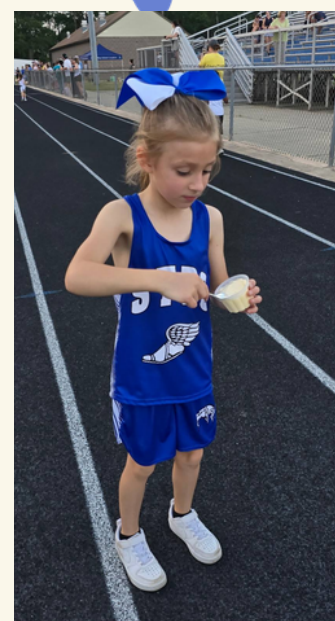
